

Instruction

Flight Instruction:

- → Cessna 172, a popular training aircraft
- → 2 hours of logged flight instruction from a Certified Flight Instructor (CFI) with student logbook provided
- → 2 hours of observation from the back seat while another camper receives instruction
- → Missionary CFIs with years of flight training and ministry experience
- → Introductory ground school session
- → Training conducted at Oshkosh Wittman Regional Airport (KOSH), home of Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA) and world famous AirVenture Oshkosh airshow



Aircraft Maintenance:

- Classroom instruction including a brief overview of aerodynamics, aircraft systems, and aviation electronics (avionics)
- → Interaction with system mock ups, hands-on projects, and state of the art computerized flight simulators

Camp Information

Cost:

- → \$650 for all camp-related costs including food, lodging, aircraft rental, and field trips
- → \$50 discount for campers registered by June 1, 2024
- → Transportation to and from area airports provided as available for an additional fee

Registration:

- → We have made our registration online. There is a link on the front page of the Wings website to register or a registration form can be obtained by downloading and printing the form from the website.

 - \$50 deposit and passport type photo
 - salvation testimony

- → Register soon; space is limited.
