

What to bring: logbook, notebook and pen, toiletries, water bottle, towels, sleeping bag, pillow, collared shirts for evening chapel, dress pants for Wednesday evening service, jeans, sweat pants for camp activities, swimming shorts, King James Bible, note pad and pencil, and a good attitude. Hair must be closely cut, neatly trimmed, and off the collar and ears.

What not to bring: music players, radios, magazines and books, pocket knives, clothing with questionable or worldly sayings, baggy pants, no shorts except for sports activities, spandex, chewing gum, jewelry (except for wrist watches, class rings, and tie clasps), tobacco, guns of any kind, or cell phones (calls must be channeled through the church office or staff phone).

Please note that Flight Camp is being held the week following Wyldewood's annual Meeting in the Air conference July 22–26, 2026, and the Experimental Aircraft Association's annual AirVenture airshow and fly-in July 20–26, 2026. There is no charge for the Meeting in the Air at Wyldewood Baptist Church, although there is a daily or weekly charge for the EAA AirVenture airshow which must be paid by those who wish to attend. Additional Meeting in the Air and AirVenture information is available upon request. Although we will do all we can to help with lodging and transportation during the Meeting in the Air and AirVenture, **we are responsible for those needs only during Flight Camp week.** If you would like to attend these other events as well as Flight Camp, please indicate that on the application form, and be prepared to handle the additional expense. When possible, we try to provide sleeping accommodations in the homes of church members of Wyldewood Baptist Church for those attending the Meeting in the Air. **We ask that you communicate early if you wish for us to help with accommodations during Meeting in the Air as lodging may only be provided if available.**

Thank you for your interest in the Wings As Eagles Flight Camp. Camp will be held at Wyldewood Baptist Church in Oshkosh, Wisconsin, beginning with registration at 5:00 PM, Sunday evening, July 26, through 11:00 AM, Saturday morning, August 1. Please advise us if you need special arrangements for early arrival.

This camp is designed for young men between the ages of 14 and 20 who are interested in missionary aviation. Accordingly the purpose of Flight Camp is two-fold: to develop missions knowledge and zeal and to encourage aviation skills.

Daily chapel services and missions classes, missionary aviation speakers, and evening preaching services will instruct and challenge you in missions and the Bible. Flight instruction with qualified flight instructors, aviation ground school classes, hands-on aircraft maintenance and repair, and field trips to local aviation attractions are designed to train and help focus you in aviation. Our camp staff is highly trained in both aviation and the gospel ministry, offering years of experience to learn from.

Total cost of the camp is \$650, of which a \$50 deposit (non-refundable except for illness or emergency) must accompany the completed application. Along with your application and deposit, please also send (1) brief salvation testimony including why you feel God would have you to be involved in missionary aviation, (2) letter of recommendation from your pastor, and (3) passport type photo. A \$50 early registration discount is available if application is submitted by June 1, 2026.

You will be notified by mail, email, or phone of your acceptance to Flight Camp. Food, lodging, aircraft rental, and field trips are provided. **Transportation to and from local airports is available for an additional fee each way (i.e. Appleton - \$15, Green Bay - \$25, Milwaukee - \$30, Chicago - \$80).**
